David D. Jefferis
 Vagabond entertainer, snake oil salesman, magician, musician, artist of stage and screen, David Dillinger Jefferis passed away October 3, 2017. David Brian Jefferis was born on March 19, 1960 in Long Beach, California to Harold H. and Lila Mae "Toddy" Reneau Jefferis. The family lived in Long Beach, Texarkana, Texas and Compton, California before settling in Anthony, Kansas. David graduated from Chaparral High School in 1978. He continued his studies at the Oklahoma School of Broadcasting, University of New Mexico and The Charles W. Howard Santa Claus School.

Elk Speaks and Wait Until Dark. He honed his skills as a clown, magician, escape artist, sword swallower and fire eater. Several years were spent at Cowtown in different roles. Most recently he was the owner of Dr. Dillinger's Freaks and Floozies, a vaudeville/burlesque review and was instrumental in bringing burlesque to Wichita. Described as a wonderful spirit and a gentle soul, David had a huge heart. He loved deeply and was a true friend of the arts. David was preceded in death by his parents, his wife Karen Jackson in 2008 and his wife Teddie Barlow in 2016. He is survived by his sisters Rhonda Berry and husband Vernon and Suni Archuleta and husband Tony, step-children Jason Lile and wife Sloane, Amy McDill and Scotty
